FIRET FIGURE.
Top and bottom couples right and left; top and mettem coaplee ohessez to the side, and then ohassor to deow: Ladies ahain; top and bottom couplea gallop sorme and beok again. Repeated by the sidea.

## SECOND FIGURE.

Top and bottom oouples forward and baok; orome orer: Chacest to the right and left, or forward and beok agala; top and bottom couples gallop acroes. Repact four timen

## THIRD FIGURE.

Top and bottom coopies right hand corosa, then left hand beok, keap hold of the band of the opposite, and form aspare giving your right hand to your partner; jou then balanee, and half promenade. Top and bottom couplea forward and back, forward again and tarn the opprosite with beth hands quite round, remume your plees: tep and botipm formard and back then oroas over - jour placom

## FOURTH FIGURE.

Fint apposite oouples forward and back; forward cain and give the partuer to leading gentleman; farmed three and beok, formard and bow, the gentlomempente forward and turn eaoh lady; then four mentanti ramal, and half right and left to pleoo. Boo mothay

## FIRST FIGURE.

All chasser to corners; bow and courtesy. All chaseez to places; bow and courtery to partaers. All balanoe apd tarn partoers with both hands. Ladies' ohain. Leadiog and opposite couples gallop acroas, turn and half right and left to places. (Repeat the above for aide coreplea.)

## SECOND FIGURE.

First and opposite Lady and Gent forward and retire; orose over; chansez to right and left; crose over to places. First and opposite couples will then polkawalis around inside of quadrille. (Repeat four timen, es above, for the others)

## THIRD FIGURE.

Trist and opposite Lady and Gent right hand going coroes, return with left hand, form a line. Balance and half promenade; first und opposite forward; redire; forwand again, bow and courtesy; then forward four and retire, thon half right and left to placea. (Repeat four timen)

## FOURTH FIGURE.

Forward four; retire; furward and leave a Lady with leading couples: forward three; retire; forward and leeve the two Ladies with opposite Gent; then, forward three again, and retire; forward to opposite Gent; four bands half round; then half right and left to places. (Repent four times.)
N. B. - The Gentlemen should al ways lead their Ladie: bookward on ench side in this figure.

## FIRST FIGURE.

First and opposite couples furward and baok; forward again and dob-a-doz. First couple gallop across while the opposite couple execute the same as first oonple. All balance and turn corners.

Reppeat four timea.

## SECOND FIGURE.

First and opposite couple forward and baok; forward again and leave the ladies in the ceutre, facing partners; ohasses to the right and lefontad turn partuers; form lines of four, with sides, forward_all and baok; forward again and turn partners in places.

Repeat fuor tiuser.

## THIRD FIGUHE.

Firstand opposite coupleaforward and back; forward again, bow and courtery, to phace.

Double Ladies' chain.

> Repent fur thes.

## FOURTH FIGURE.

First and opposite couples forward to side couples on the right, bow and courtesy, then change to side couplea on the left, bow and courtesy; all chassez and turn partners to places; first and oppusite couples right and left.

Repeat four times.

## FIFTH FIGURE.

All grand chain round; form in line with the leads; all chassez; march, filing right and left, up the centre; fall back in columus; forward all and back; forward ad tura partners to places.

## First figure.

Frot and opposite couples forward, change hands, sabern to places, waltz round to places, balance, and - Elelte round to places. Repeat for side couples.

## SECOND FIGURE.

Frat couple double waltz twice until they get to oppusite, then rights hande across, and left hands back, first conple waltz to place. Repeat four times.

## THIRD FIGURE.

Firt oouple waltz round outside to the side oouple en the right, oross with right hands, then with left hande, then frat couple waltz, waltz round side oouple to their sheos ; frat and opposite couples waltz round to places. tepent four timen.

## fourth figure.

Prat couple, forward or waltz up to the opposite couThe, execute the passes, then first couple waltz to plaoe. bepmet four times.

## FIFTH FIGURE.

All promeande round; all balance; firat oouple formad beokwhif with lady, turn and return to place, then round isuide of quadrille. Bepeat four times.

## FIRST FIGURE.

First and opposite couples forward and cross hands, co once round to place; firet and opposite balance and turn partners; Ladies' chain; balf prumenade aud half Hight and left. Repeat for the side couples.

## SECONO FIGURE.

First gentlemen forward and back twice; four ladies belance to the right and turn the gentlemen on the Een. Ropeat four times until they get their own partHers

## third figure.

The first lady and opposite gentiemen forward aud theck, forward again and dos-a-dos; first couple gallop erem, while opposite couple pass outuite across; reyan to place; all balance corners and turn partaers: th take bands, forward and back, forward and turn perters.

## FOURTH FIGURE.

First lady and opposite gentleman forward and stop; find ampeman and opposite lady firward and stop, - ${ }^{2}$ tara partaers to their places; four ladies forward the fight to each ladies' place, and turn the geatlewhe right band; four gentlemen furward to the Thant strat the Indies' with right hand; repeat twice whris 37 presenade round to places and turn partuers. tranis the nide.

## FIRST FIGURE.

First and opposite couples promenade round, waltz round, balance, and waitz round, Side couples the wame.

## SECONO FIGURE.

First couple waltz to side couple, cbange of ladies, the same to bottom and side couples; first and opposite coople waltz round to places. Repeat for the side on the right, then bottom and side couples, until all get partuers.

## THIRD FIGURE.

First and opposite couples waltz round outsido, cross hands with side couple, then change ladios and waltz to placen ; second time, waltz to the left, then to the rigbt, then to left, until all get their partuers.

## fourth figure.

First and opposite couple waltz round to the centre, make the passes, then change of ladies and waltz to each ladies place. Repeat fur side couples.

## Fifth figure.

All give right hands to corners, all turn a full circle round, then left hand to next until they get to partners opposite of their places, then all waltz to places; ladies cross with right hands, the gentlemen with right hand with ladies left hand; wll promenade half round, then turn half round and return to places. Repeat as above, and with the same time as the old polka quadrilles.

## ©arpentrr's SMazounlia (Quadrilles.

First Introduction-wait; hands round to the left, then to the right to places; all turn partiners and mako a little tour round; then a little waliz in place.

## FIRST FIGURE.

First couple promenade round inside of Quadrille to place; execute the square baiance and little waltz.

Counterpart for the otieer couples.
Becond Introduction-wait; all in.waltz position, then slide quarter round, with the pitching step, or jetes; then waltz, until all are half round; repeat to places.

## SECOND FIGURE.

First couple forward to the right and four hands round; go to bottom couple, cross hauds; go to side couples, where two ladies go round each other, while gentlemen go round outside ; first couple go to plece, and make a little waltz.

Repoat for the other couplea.
Third Introduction-wait; all waltz round.

## THIRD FIQURE.

First couple forward to side couples, and take two ladies to centre of quadrille; three hands round to loft, then to right; leave your partner with side gentlemen; do the eane to bottom and side cuuples; take the last lady to place, and execute the little waltz; repest antil all get their partners.

Fourth Introduction-wait; all promenade half round, then make a little tour; all repeat to places.

## FOURTH FIGURE.

First and opposite couple coupee ; first and opposite balance round with right hands, then with left handa. Repeat for sides.

## FIPTH FIGURE.

Wait; all hands round to the left then to the right; all make the little tour and little waltz; all face partners; all promenade round to each quarter of quadjille, and execute the little waltz, gentlemen to the right, Iadies to the left, antil all get partners.

FIRST FIGURE.
Firgt and opposite couples half right and left, all turn corners ; first and opposite half rightand left, and all turn corners; first and opposite couples walta round outside to places, while the side couples forward and change hands and return to places; all waliz around. Repeat for aide couples.

## 6ECOND FIGURE.

First couple waltz round inside; double ladies chain and turn the gentlemen twice round, aad then the ladies oross hands and take the opposite gentlemen to ledien' places. Repeat four times for partaers.

## THIRD FIGURE.

First and opposite couples waliz round outside of side couples, and meet in the centre; first and opposite couples cross hands with right and then left hands half right and left with sitlo couple, all waltz to places; firat and opposite couples whliz. Repeat four times.

## FOURTH FIGURE.

First couple waltz to the centre of quadrille; the gentlemen will then turn ench lady with right hand, beginning on the right; turn the lady and then his partner. All waltz round while the first couple is in the centre. Repeat fuur times.

## FIFTH FIGURE.

Grand right and left all around; gentlemen will then go to the centre, standing back to thack while the four ladies right and left round the gentlemen; the gentlemen turn the ladies round with right hande, and then the geatlemen oross with left hands and promenade with ladies to places. Repent four times.

## FINALE.

Gentlemen turn the ladies with left hands; ladies croas handa; then gentlemen turn the ladies, and gentlemen form aoross; the ladies will go round back ander gentlemen'e arms; waltz to place then all walta round.

## First figure.

Top and bottom couplon walts round inside of quadrille, while the side couples balance with right and left hands

ECTAll grand half ohain and waltz to place; side couple waltz round inside of quadrille, while the leading couples balance with right and left hands.

All grand half ohain and waltz to place; top and bottom couples balanoe in squares with side couples four times; all waltz to each side of quadrille.

## SECOND FIGURE.

Grand gallop; all gallop across, turn partners once round with right hand; all gallop again, turn partners; all forward and cross hands in the centre, and then all walte to sides again ; all march to centre; march by four up the room, then divide by twos, going round the room; all gallop and waltz to the (finale.)

## FIRST FIGURE.

First and seoond couples leads to the right and salute; gentlemen give left hand to lady of the right hand couple, retaining their partner's left band: cross over to the place of their ris-a-vis; ladies continued chain; face partners and salute; all ohassez to the right and loft and turn partners.

## 8ECOND FIGURE.

La Nouvelle Treni.-First gentlemen and opposite lady forward and turn with both hands, stoping in front of the single lady; oross over; the single lady passing in between the couple and turn with opposite gentlemen; forward four and back; half ladies' chain and turn corners.

THIRD FIGURE.

La Corbsills.- First gentlemen lead his lady to the centre, facing him and salute; seonad, third and fourth gentlemen do the same; ladies hands round; gentlemen forward and take hands of ladies, forward all and turn partners.

## FOURTH FIGURE.

La Dowble Pastourelle.-First and opposite forward and back, forward again and leave the ladies with side couples: forward siz and back, the remaining two forward and back, forward to the right and aciute; four hand half round and half right and lef to places.

## FIFTH FIGURE

Le Towrbilon. -Ladies to the right and tarn gentlemen with right hand; first and opposite lady and gentlemen forward and back, forward again and salute. Repeat this figure until each couple has repeated it, and then to the finale. Ladies to the right and turn, all forward and back, forward again and leare the lady in the oentre; all salute.
