THE MAXIXE

(The Flirtation Steps) This step is done by the man winging to the right of parter and looking at her, then winging to the left and again ooking, still keeping up the ame step, the girl turning her lead first to the right, then to he left, looking at the man. After this comes a forward tep, the man again directly beaind the girl, taking two lefts ind two rights as before; then he man places one hand to girl's waist and one at side, pending from side to side, raisng hands over head when to he right and down to side when on the left, then both rands to the waist, and continue steps.
