2^d Couplet.



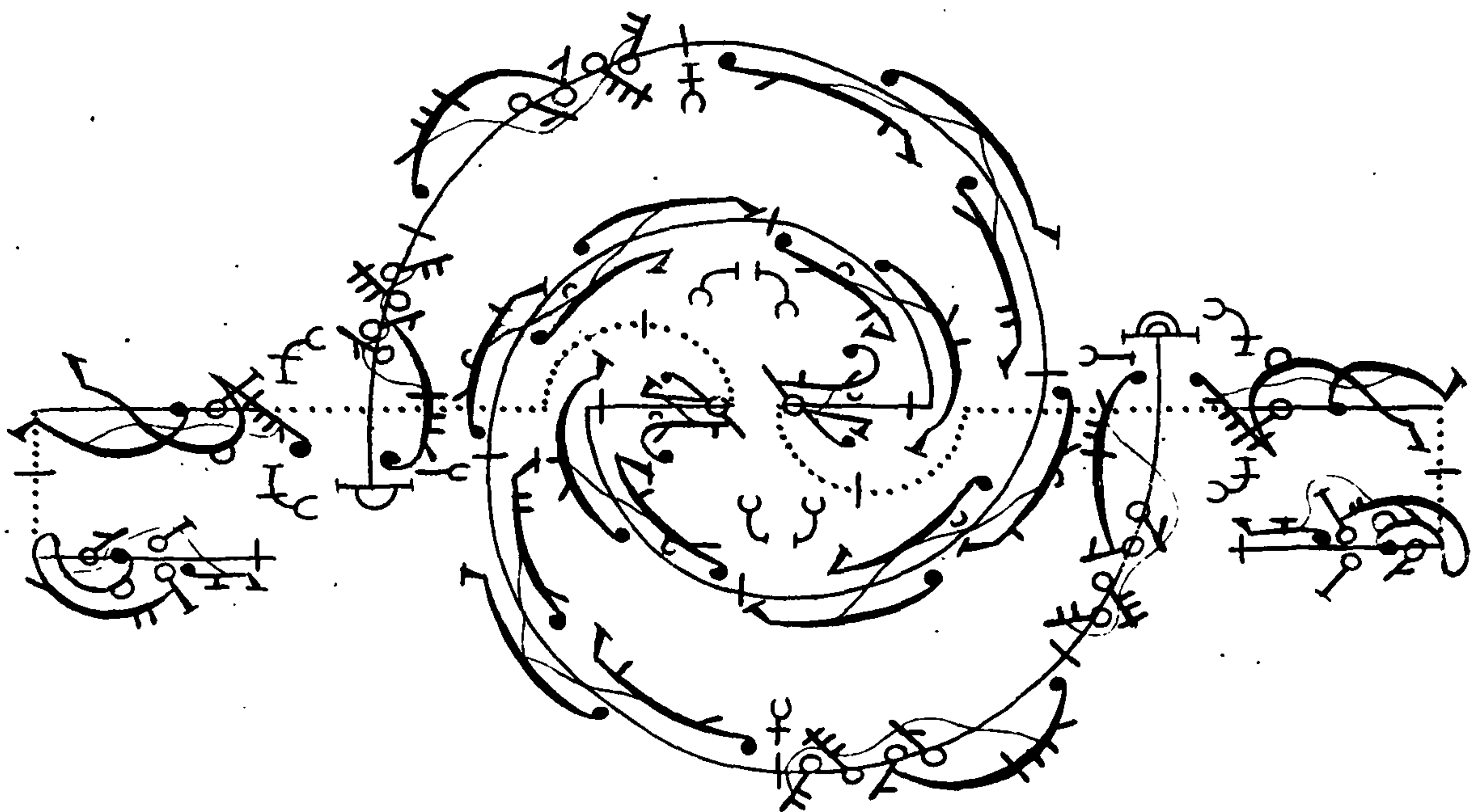
