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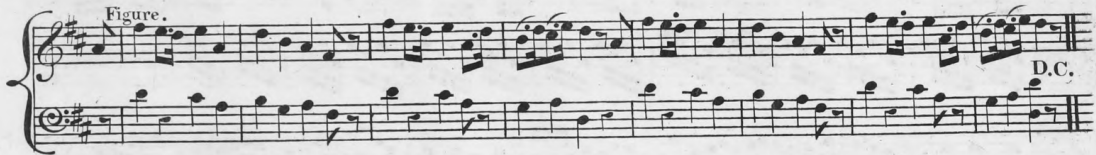
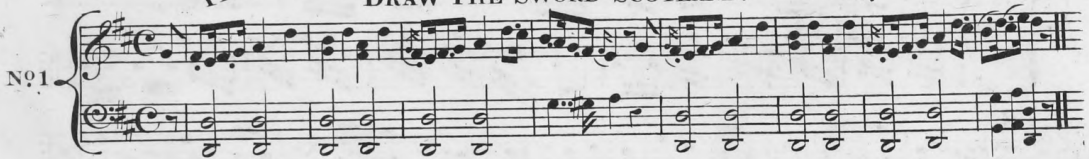

DRAW THE SWORD SCOTLAND.



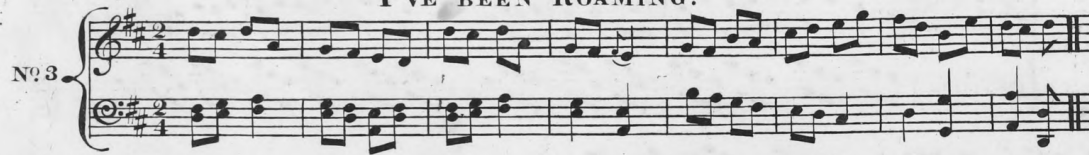
Right and Left — Chasse' — Ladies Chain — Promenade and half right and left to place.
