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DESCRIPTION

Position:— Partners stand side by side, lady's left hand in the gentleman's right.
Gentleman commences with the left foot, lady commences with the right foot.

STEP FOR THE GENTLEMAN

Jetté outwards and inwards.....	2 bars
Pas Marche 3 steps, turning on the fourth and facing in opposite direction, changing hands same time.....	2 bars
Jetté outwards and inwards.....	2 bars
Pas Marche 3 steps, turning on the fourth to face partner, joining both hands.....	2 bars
Jetté to left, then to the right.....	2 bars
Chassé four steps to left, still retaining both hands.....	2 bars
Ordinary waltz.....	4 bars
