STEPS FOR GENTLEMEN, (Lady Counterpart):-

First Movement:-		Glide left forward, bring right instep to heel of left foot, step forward Left and Right	1 Bar.
Second	„	Repeat above	1 Bar.
Third	„	Chasse Round	2 Bars.
Fourth	„	Chasse Forward, left and right	2 Bars.
Fifth	„	(ROLL) Glide left, bring right instep to heel of left, cross left in front of right, bring right to close position (Lady brings right foot behind left in making the roll)	1 Bar.
Sixth	„	Pas de Marche left and right	1 Bar.
Repeat Movements		1, 2 and 3.	4 Bars.
Repeat		5 and 6	2 Bars.
Final Movement:-		Pas de Marche	2 Bars.
Total =			<u><u>16 Bars.</u></u>
